

## **OPTION SUBJECT: Cambridge National Sports Studies Level1/2 Award.**

What type of qualification will I achieve?	Cambridge National Sports studies Level1/2 Award.
What will I be doing in my lessons and what skills will I gain?	The course is equivalent to one GCSE. Students study four units during the two years. Each one offers students different opportunities to develop their knowledge and understanding of the practice and theory behind the modern-day sporting world. One of the units is externally examined. In the other three units' students are assessed through a variety of methods including presentations, written coursework, practical demonstrations and leadership.
How and when will my work be assessed?	<ul> <li>The four units' students will complete are:</li> <li>1. Contemporary Issues (Externally Examined)</li> <li>2. Developing Sports Skills (Practical Unit - 2 sports)</li> <li>3. Media in Sport (Written Coursework)</li> <li>4. Sports Leadership (Practical Unit)</li> </ul>
How much time will I need to work on this subject out of lesson time?	GCSE PE students are expected to attend afterschool clubs each week to improve practical scores. GCSE PE students are also expected to represent house teams and school teams when it comes to competition and complete theory-based homework each week.
What will this course lead to in the Sixth Form?	The Cambridge National in Sports Studies provides students with the skills needed to either continue into the Sixth Form/ college to study Level 3 PE courses, or to go straight into the sporting industry to put their knowledge into practice.
