

PUTIN'S OBSESSION WITH UKRAINE AND CRIMEA

Where is Ukraine and Crimea?

Ukraine is in Eastern Europe. It borders Poland, Belarus, Romania and Russia. It used to be part of the Russian Empire and the USSR but was given independence after its collapse. Crimea is to the south of the Ukraine and was given to Ukraine in the USSR.

NATO and the EU

Ukraine was to join these organisations as they promote democracy and would back them up if there was conflict. However, they have not been accepted at present due to closeness to Russia.

RUSSIA

Russia don't want Ukraine to join as it would reduce their power. They threatened to turn off Ukraine's power if they joined the EU. In the east and south there are many Pro-Russian people who want to be part of Russia again leading to conflict.

Why does Putin want Ukraine and Crimea?

It would give Russia better military control over the Black Sea. They have a port in Crimea but have to pay a lease to Ukraine. It would also give Russia better access to Europe.

Natural Resources

'Undeclared war' - In 2014 Russia seized Crimea and it is not under their control. This has promoted Pro-Russia uprisings in South Ukraine. Europe and the US did little to help as they get energy from Russia.

The USA won the physical geography lottery for a variety of reasons: The coastline provided lots of places for ships to dock and the land meant food Natural harbours and fertile soils could be easily grown. The mountains provided a barrier to stop attacks from the west while The Appalachian Mountains settlements developed. The Declaration of Independence was signed in 1776 which meant they were Freedom from the British freed of British rule. The Mississippi provided great inland transport and gave access to the Gulf of The Mississippi River Mexico increasing trade. Alaska Major gold and oil deposits were found in Alaska. The British gave the USA all of their naval bases in the W. hemisphere in World War II exchange for help in WW2.

Massive reserves of oil and natural gas meaning the USA could be self sufficient.
